Players must be Canadian citizens and eligible

POINTS TALLY

Born in 1995 and younger

Two Players qualify through a points tally; the third player will be a coach selection. The event is an open event. Players may participate at their own expense.

To be eligible for the World Junior Championships team qualifier - to be played at the ITTF North American Championships - players must be Canadian citizens and eligible as per ITTF Rules; for individual event players must be Permanent Residents.

Team selection: **July 25, 2013**

Two Players qualify through a points tally; the third player will be a coach selection

Team selection: **October 10, 2013**

ITTF World Ranking:	1 st 40 pts, 2 nd 28 pts, 3 rd 16 pts, 4 th 8 pts

For all events, last available rankings will be used.



CADET BOYS / CADET GIRLS

ITTF North American Championships August 25-27, 2013

CAN Junior Open – ITTF Junior Circuit Vancouver, BC August 29 – September 1, 2013

Players must be Permanent Residents to participate in the events.

ITTF World Cadet Challenge October 26 – Nov 3, tbc

Born in 1998 and younger

Two Players qualify through a points tally. The event is an open event. Players may participate at their own expense. The competition may have an entry restriction with respect to the number of entries per national association.

Team selection: **July 25, 2013**

Canadian Cadet Ranking:	1 st 40 pts, 2 nd 28 pts, 3 rd 16 pts, 4 th 8 pts
ITTF World Cadet Ranking:	1 st 30 pts, 2 nd 21 pts, 3 rd 12 pts, 4 th 6 pts

(Individual competition results as per actual result;
all rankings are among Canadian eligible players)

The CAN Junior Open and the ITTF North American Championships are open events (up to a maximum entry as per the tournament prospectus). However, to qualify for financially supported selection, players must be Canadian citizens, since the competition is part of the preparation/selection for the ITTF World Cadet Challenge.
Players may participate at their own expense.

The selection to Team North America is governed by ITTF North America Selection Policy.

The National Team budget will offer support to the
3 players (per gender) for the World Junior Championships (as per National Team Selection Policy.)
2 cadet players and 3 junior players (per gender) for the ITTF North America Championships; (athlete contribution fees will be determined once 2013-14 Sport Canada National Team funding is known).
