Luo Anqi and Moran Alexander, two Ontario Players solely representing Canada at the 2014 Road to Nanjing Series- North America

Commencing the ITTF international table tennis events week was the 2014 Road to Nanjing Series- North America held April 7-8th at My Table Tennis Club, Mississauga. The competition saw the arrivals of talented young players from all across the globe, seizing for a chance at the 2014 Nanjing Youth Olympics Games. Representing the host nation, Canada were Ontario players Luo Anqi and Moran Alexander competing in the Junior Girls' Singles and Junior Boys' singles event respectively.

It was a good effort of Alexander Moran who lost out on a position in the main draw after being overcame by Nielsen Claus (Den) and Allegro Martin (Bel). However, he managed a win over Tsao Emy (AUS) by score of 3-1.

It was a smoother sail for Luo Anqi, who managed to lay claim to a position in the main draw after defeating out Piccolin Giorgia (Ita) and Fins Rita (Por). Unfortunately, she was later defeated by the Hungarian player Imre Leila at the semi-finals by scores of (11-9, 9-11, 9-11, 10-12, 12-14).

Austrian player Levenko Andreas and Belgian player Lisa Lung became the final victors to the 2014 Road to Nanjing Series- North America tournament. Nonetheless, Luo Anqi and Moran Alexander both have a chance to redeem themselves at the following the 2014 Youth Olympic Games Continental Qualification- North America set to occur the subsequent day at the very same venue.
