



Selection for 2023 Canadian Junior Championships, July 2023

Teams

- Top 3 in single events will be selected for the Ontario Team
- The 4th player for the team will be selected by the OTTA; following criteria will be used: Ontario Ranking List, number of played events in 52 weeks prior to entry deadline for Canadian Championships, Ontario Championships results including doubles, most recent results

Singles

- TTCAN may impose entry restrictions for each province; if so:
 - Semi-finalists from Ontario Championships will have priority
 - Other players will be selected based on position at Ontario Ranking List at The Canadian Championships registration date

Doubles

- Selection priority based on Ontario Championships final standings
- in the event that the number of available slots at the Canadian Championships exceeds the number of standings brackets (4 or 8), combined Ontario Ranking points will be applied to determine selected pairs

- players without High Performance membership will need to pay additional administration fees besides TTCAN registration fees and attend mandatory 3 days training camp before deadline to register for Canadian Championships

Important Note: The TTCAN has not yet released a prospectus for the 2023 Canadian Juniors Championships. It is possible that categories (particularly doubles and mixed doubles) deviate from those predicted here. As there is no more information on Canadian Championships categories, available slots for Ontario, and events (categories), the OTTA organizes provincial championships and establishes qualifying standards in good faith.
